Report of the Crawley and Horsham LCB Meeting – 4th October 2006

Appointments and Membership

- Andreia Moniz, Student Representative was welcomed to the Board. A Representative from Crawley Borough Council, Jarnail Singh had also recently joined the Board, but was unfortunately not able to attend this meeting.
- A business representative from the Horsham area was still being sought.

Strategy

- Information on the Organisational Development was received by the Board, including the strategic context for the proposals and the need to develop an organisation fit for the future and capable of delivering the five-year vision. The College high and medium priorities were noted.
- The Board was advised of the Crawley Masterplan and noted the Education Strategy was the driver for the Masterplan. The Masterplan was discussed in some detail and in particular the transport implications were considered.
- The Board considered the Mission, Vision and Values.
